found them. Showing a steam gate from  
the mouth with snow

FRIDAY 11

(1340)

Self making a log rack Sumner helping  
Boston at stacks, a fine field day  
all hands packing & about of fire house must  
on the side find back

WEDNESDAY 9

(1335)

SATURDAY 12

(1332)

Self arrived from Joseph's camp the afternoon  
Sumner & Johnson went of to get the horses  
I found 2 Indian boys coming from  
Joseph's having some food from Jack back  
to report it to the Indians having killed 2 moose  
the boys got back a fine field day

Self & Boston & Sumner went of to  
find back with the dogs after some time  
back and got back about 4 P.M. together I  
arrived from Johnson's before report having  
a hard day snow very deep.  
Sunday 13  
A cold stormy day Boston  
at N. Kope's traps all day
