- Monday 6. Fine day John Shaw send a canoe of loads to the Lake. by Mochor & Talan.
- Tuesday 7 Fine day nothing doing
- Wednesday 8 " " Joseph after horses.
- Thursday 9 very quiet Am @ & John's
- Friday 10. Ruined a little during the night
- Saturday 11 " " " " " day the ice started to flow in the river again. this is the second time this winter.
- Sunday 12 very cloudy to day nothing doing and must say it is a very dull place to be @.
- Monday 13 Went after Hay to day
- Tuesday 14 Joe hauling fire wood.
- Wednesday 15 Ice flowing very thick in the river. Tuscally arrived but did not come near this place. but went straight to Deeme. and traded what few furs he had.
- Thursday 16 the ice still flowing very thick but the weather is very fine for this time of the year
- Friday 17 Burbank the trader about ready to start for the Big Five River where he intends to winter. and toward the spring is going to push further onto the Nelson's River he has a large outfit of Dry Goods.
- Saturday 18. Fine day very quiet
- Sunday 19 Burbank started off today for his Post on the Pine River a few Indians arrived. traded a few furs
- Monday 20. Very quiet
- Tuesday 21 Fine day very little Ice flowing in the river
- Wednesday 22 Joseph after horses
- Thursday 23 " " and managed to bring them in
- Friday 24 Went after a load of hay with the team and a pair of Bob Sleigh but upset coming down. but no serious accident.
