(326-39)

The Indians left this morning for their camp.  
Self in store Samson & Henry hunting and  
arrived  
a fine clear day with a warm wind

WEDNESDAY 23

(327-38)

Self went down and brought some dog from  
Samson at about a fine clear  
night day.  
one of the old women very sick

NOVEMBER

THURSDAY 24

(328-37)

1010

Self hunting with Samson at about  
a fine clear day  
Indians arrived from  
Charles Lake & re-packed 2 more that  
started to snow about 8 PM

FRIDAY 25

(329-36)

Samson and making a trail for 6 hours here  
Self working in office  
Hunting with Samson & Joseph  
arrived from Lake along River and re-packed  
every one with in their camp. but no shells  
luckily with snow fast of the day  
The 3 Indians left this morning.  
repacked faces last night and set up back  
white bear in dead traps

SATURDAY 26

(330-35)

Self in office Samson and cutting  
Hunting with Samson at about a fine clear  
day.  
Self & Samson cutting up faces and fish  
them near the River
