(89-277)

all the white men left for H. Hope where they
 are going to take up land
 self at old jobs
 Takola arrived
 continues cold but clearing
 up

SATURDAY, 30

(90-276)

Self at old jobs a fine warm day
 during a strong breeze
 snow nearly all gone
 2 other Indians arrived
 this morning to start sampling
 Mr. Burcut left

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
