Self busy with Indians all day  
a pair of horses & harness arrived from  
St. Hope  
Mrs. Milligan's party arrived from St. Hope  
cloudy and looks like rain

THURSDAY, 16

(137-229)

Rain all last night and continued  
nearly all day Self in office  
& Mrs. Rose arrived from the St. Pierre  
side of the River  
This evening

FRIDAY, 17

(138-228)

Self busy with Indians a few horses  
arrived from St. Hope  
The River crossing up for  
Mrs. Milligan's party arrived from  
in the St. Pierre
