and broke just before leaving
busy handling up A.B. frost

THURSDAY, 24

(298-68)

1912

Self busy loading boat for the Hope
Lumber arrived from below.
Came in from Brattford River
a fine clear
day
Wablin left for home

FRIDAY, 25

(299-67)

The snow left this morning for the Hope
also Mr. Brattford & party left for the coast
started to snow about 11 am and continued
all day fell about 4 inches of snow
cleared up much snow
Self busy with Indians
the Indians are patched up
Monday all

SATURDAY, 26

(300-66)

The last of the Indians patched up
to day Cold all day
Self in office
Samson after horses

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
