a few Indians arrived fine weather

Wednesday 14
 The Indians started back to their camps fine air warm
 still no sign of the canoe from below

Thursday 15
 Cloudy air looks like rain J. Chapman and a boy
 arrived from Hope with a canoe under rainy feet

Friday 16
 J. Chapman cutting fire wood. Man still using the canoe
 busy working in garden McDaniel working in office

Saturday 17
 Clarence fine looks like rain 2 white men arrived
 from the mountains with horses for supplies
 their canoe.

Sunday 18
 busy trading all day a band of Indians
 arrived Kuntayins band arrived this
 evening
