the River this evening

A fine clear day self taking up
potatoes
Angus and myself down the
River having ploughed about 10 acres

Wednesday 9
Claude and my train a hard frost
last night Angus & McLeod went
up to Sugar place & Stalks out
self at potatoes

Thursday 10
Rain again this morning self at
old jobs the Police left for St Hope

Friday 11
Cold and stormy self in office
D. Cadmus arrived from Peace River
with horse.

Saturday 12
Cold last night very hard frost
self finish taking up the potatoes
to clear the Assiniboia arrived from St Hope

Sunday 13
A fine clear day
