Tuesday 14
 Cloudy and looks like snow. a
 report from Hope that a man has
 been found shot some where across
 the bridge

Wednesday 15
 Snowed nearly all last night cleared up
 this morning. Furs arrived from
 Beatty Curpie with freight for Gadenbuck
 The Chief Constable Taylor left this
 morning for Hudsons Hope
