Rear Penice this morning
the apparatus arrived from St. Peter

Wednesday 7th
a very fine day self being 2 miles
south of Clarins, mail between here
the mail arrived

Thursday 8th
the mail left this morning a lot
of mail arrived from the north
and brought some news some of
them paid their debts self being
in store
