Friday 9

The Indians left this morning for their camp. Self in office. Friends Ludwell came from up the South River. He has been trapping for the winter. 2 men came down on a raft from Hope this evening.

Saturday 10

A fine clear day. Self at odd jobs. River very fast.

Sunday 11

1 man arrived in a small motor boat this morning from P.B. King on the way to Hope. Cloudy and overcast. Mr Macdougall arrived from Hope this evening. River still coming up.

Monday 12

Macdougall left this morning for home. Heavy or strong gale of west wind.

Tuesday 13

10 Indians arrived from the north and paid their debts. Self very busy in store. Water coming up fast.

Wednesday 14

Self busy in store. The Indians left at noon. Joe Lippasson arrived and paid his debt. The S.S. River boat arrived from P.B. King with a number of passengers & freight for Hope. She left after a short stay here. Self sowed some garden seeds up at the ranch this evening.
