the Pauls back and from the  
crossing

Thursday 2

a fine clear day self busy in store  
with Indians Ma Tu Kwa and a few  
others came in 2 sent John down  
to give them flour at the old Post  
The Bill Banger along with Willie  
& Duncans left for the Pine to  
pick out some furs
