 winter weather. Self at wood
 had a visit from Mrs. TB. Mrs. Watt
 busy in office.

Friday 4th

a fine clear day. Self busy in the
 Joe Harrington arrived and brought a few
 furs. Sam Lasker & Culpit got back
 from the ~~Sakum~~ Portas River where
 they had made a trip with freight.
 They report some deaths amongst
 the Indians at Sakum River.

Saturday 5th

Blowing and snow drifting all day.
 3 Indians arrived from Sakum Camp
 and report very little furs. Self at oil jobs.
 we had a meeting of our association here
 today. Joe Harrington arrived
 and brought some furs.
