letter in afternoon. Willie went
to the Lake for a load of lumber
a gas & wash passed down the River
this evening. Cloudy towards evening
and looks like snow

Friday 28

Cloudy with a little rain, but
at 4:30 Willie went up with the
mail and took his mother up. Always
with him she will stay with Margaret
for a few days at Rich Creek. Mail goes
out this evening. George got back from
Sakonia Post with Paul's train.

Saturday 29

Weather best cold night & morning
Went making rafters for the Horse Stable
River falling. Mr. Pickett lost his car
last night on Taylor Flat Hill while
going up in the dark he missed the
Point and upset with 3 passengers and
the car caught fire, and was completely
destroyed but no one was hurt.

Sunday 30

Very cold & cloudy wind from North
Willie took up a load of Knight's
help went up to Rich Creek in afternoon
started to snow about 3 o'clock and lasted
about 1 1/2 hours. Very cold towards evening.
Mary & Douglas came for a visit.
John Thomas & Brother came from Paul
Cave on their way north to trap.
I camped at Rich Creek.
