Thursday 2

Weather fine. Self writing letters. Willie went for Hay. Will be back tomorrow. George & Peter brought down 2 loads of M. C. Lumber. The cattle came home from the hills this evening. The snow is all gone on the hill side in fact there is very little snow left on the flats.

Friday 3

Cloudy. Wind from East and looks like snow. Willie came home with a load of feed. Self went up to take counts for a few supplies.

Co. Coakishen brought his horse Mashael in from the North River and is taking him out to the Duster. He has been sick all winter. A McLead left with freight for Siskinnia River for the H.B.
