Started to mow early this morning and continued mowing all day with a cold North wind. Stopped mowing towards evening but very cloudy very little doing. Willie & Fred went up the hill, the cattle came back from the Island this morning

April 1928

Sunday 1

Cold and stormy wind from the North. Willie brought a load of hay.

Monday 2

Self & Willie cut some fire wood in the morning and all hauled it in afternoon. Cold all day and cloudy but cleared up towards bed time. I had that the N.T. Inspector who is staying with Harris was to leave today. The McLeods got back from the Salmon River when they had taken H.B. traps. They got some louse on their way back and had a fight Angus came in with the McLeods
