evening. Self took up the turkeys
in the Garden. Bleas. Boat sent
from H. Hager. This evening and camped
here for the night.

Thursday 11

Clear this morning but cold all
day. Bleas Boat left this morning.
They took a load of wheat. Bleas
self went up the hill very cold.
driving in cloudy towards evening.
Boat camped left for his boat with freight.

Friday 12

Cloudy all day. Wind from west.
I went up to see the boys as they may
leave tomorrow for this trap line.
a little rain toward evening.

Saturday 13

Cloudy in morning with rain
but cleared about noon and very
mild. Snow a strong west wind.
Angus & Miller came down and we
put in 73 Sks Potatoes 43 Sks in Boat
fence & 30 in cills. We have a few
drills to dig up yet.

The balsam going around in the
way north to trap.
Mail arrived.
