 The boys finished the potatoes
 62 sacks. H. Meares boat arrived
 from the Crossing with a load
 of freight he had a hard trip as
 the water is very low, he is
 going on to H Hope

Wednesday 9

Weather fine busy at odd jobs the
 boys still going down.
 Meares Boat left this morning
 for Hudson Hope
