 from his trap, he has been gone
 over a month. Carl Mikkleson
 got back from Jones Post this afternoon.

Tuesday 28

Snowed nearly all day. I went
 up to the Police Station to sign some
 papers for the Police. snow was all
 drifted over. Willie hauled some
 firewood cleared up towards evening
 for a short time and started to snow
 again about 7 o'clock.

Wednesday 29

a fine mild day. Frank got the team
 and drove up to the barnyard for
 some supplies for the boat. Willie
 cutting firewood and hauled
 one load Mrs B very sick.
 Snowed again this evening.

Thursday 30

Started to snow early this morning
 and continued all day. I went up to
 the Barracks and held court along with
 Mr. Abbott. W. McLeod was up for trial
 and got off with a fine of 25.00 and costs.
 No mail roads all drifted over.
 Willie went for a load of straw.
