Monday 9

Cloudy with a few showers. H Weavers Boat arrived from the Crossing he had 2 passengers for here. After a short stay he left for Hudson Hope. The H.B. Pack train arrived from the north bringing with the returns of Ben. Also there 2 Post Managers W Sandnes from Sikkima Post + J. Beaton + Wife from Nag Creek Post. I was busy in my garden all day.

Tuesday 10

A fine clear day. I went to Georges place and got some sheaves. Jeanon went up to Serge Bayonne, and brought down his stepdaughters to stay with us. The River coming up fast.

Wednesday 11

I went up to the Post Office but no mail. I also went up over to the H.B. Store for a few groceries. W Sandnes + Johnny came down for a visit. Very cloudy this evening.

Thursday 12

Cloudy and overcast started to rain about noon and continued the rest of the day. Willie brought our mail down.

Friday 13

Rain all last night and all day. The H.B. M.B. Weemush arrived from P.R. after a short stay they left for Hudson Hope. I went up to see the Boys records very bad. The River is very high higher than it has been for a number of years.
