Saturday 29

Cold and stormy with a little snow. I went up with some mail to the P.O. this afternoon.

Very cloudy this evening. The River nearly froze over.

Sunday 30

Snowed all last night and continued most of the day. Wind from N. N. E. Cleared up towards evening.

December 1930

Monday 1

A fine clear day. I was busy at the wood pile. We got a very bad cold. Miller came down this evening and brought a load of sheaves. Cloudy this evening. Wind from S. W. and very mild.

Tuesday 2

A fine mild day. Miller and I hauled a load of firewood. Then Miller went up to look after the horses. F. Handgren & Mr. Heaton came down to look at the bridge on the creek. They called in on their way. Mr. Heaton is the new road boss and has some men cutting up the road from Anderson's corner to the top of the hill. The River still open but lots of ice running.
