Thursday 22

Continues mild blowing a east wind I drove up to the Post office with some mail the Boys brought 2 loads of feed started to blow a strong N W wind this evening

Friday 23

a strong North wind all last night but calmed down this morning fine all day but cold Willie brought a load of feed leaving at Wood & ad jobs 15 below 5 nights at bed time
