Cold and stormy all day, snows all drifted over. Willie went up to trap place after dinner. A lot of Ice in the River. I was busy at Wood and odd jobs.

Saturday 2

A fine mild day, very cloudy, a lot of Ice going down. Willie came down with a few sheaves. The mail did not get in. Very mild this evening.

Sunday 3

Cold all day, a lot of Ice going down the River.

Monday 4

20 below Z this morning, cold all day. Laurence + Willie came down and we killed the big Steer. The River full of Ice and I think it is jammed down at the bend, 18 below this evening.

Tuesday 5

Started to snow early this morning and continued all day. Willie went home after dinner. Ice still running. Bleared up about 9 o'clock. To night it fell about 9 in of snow. The S.S. Police arrived from Ft Nelson with dog team.
