Wednesday 6

A fine clear day but cold the River still open. Ice moving down cloudy this evening and started to snow again

Thursday 7

Cold and stormy wind from north the River still open but lot of ice going down. Willie came down this evening the mail still held up at Taylor flat as they cannot cross the River it has been there now over a week

Friday 8

14 below zero this morning a fine clear day lot of ice in the River Willie went home at noon cold towards evening 22 below a fine clear day

Saturday 9

20 below this morning cold all day the River froze over in some places and should be closed up by evening still no mail 21 below to night

Sunday 10

Cold and stormy all day 28 below this morning the River froze over last night or early this morning
