A light frost last night. Treaty will be paid to the Indians today at the Reserve. Johnny is going along as Inspector. The Boys finished cutting the wheat this evening. 5 loads of letters, affixes passed north today also a few cows

Wednesday 22

Cloudy and cold wind from north started to rain about 9:30 this morning and continued most of the day. Johnny went to the Indian Reserve with the Dr. Brown.

Thursday 23

17 Rained a little this morning but cleared up towards noon. Big way busy at odd jobs Frank but 2 loads of fire wood from George's place

Friday 24

A fine clear day I drove down to the River this morning. Sun is steady then the River going down the roads are drying up but very rough
