Went to look at woods. All day and started to snow towards evening. All hands went to the ground and out for wood & stones to go.

FRIDAY 22 (22-344)

Samson cutting firewood. Very much the river to look for birch trees for a stand. With view to the traps the birds

SATURDAY 23 (23-343)

With N odd jobs. A fine clear day. Sunday 24
