Thursday 30

Continues cold and stormy. Duncan plowing. I was busy at wood most of the day. Very few trees coming as the roads are getting bad.

October 1937

Friday 1

Snowed early this morning but cleared a little about noon. I drove over to the H/S store after dinner the roads very windy and lots of water. The Yukon Mail Plain passed out on her way to Esmeraldas this evening. Very cloudy to night and started to snow.

Saturday 2

Continues cold and stormy with snow. Very little doing. I was busy at fire wood. The Birley family came for a visit. Duncan got the mail it was late in getting on account of bad roads.
