Friday, 21

Blowing a strong gale of wind from south west all day, I drove to the NS Store this morning, the snow all drifted over, very heavy, going no trucks or cars passed here to day. Frank came back from the C Lake where he has been cutting fire wood

Saturday, 22

A fine mild day, Frank making bunks for the sled trail at ad jobs, the wind changed to knots east this evening and turned very cold and started to snow

Sunday, 23

a fine, clear day

Monday, 24

25 below zero this morning, I drove over and got the mail this morning and left this morning for the trap line along with Dones teams. 2 planes arrived from Edmonton one going to Yukon, the following from AK this evening and started to snow. The McLeod teams got back they could not make it Nelson
