lots of snow in the bush yet
especially out north but on the
open fields nearly all gone
there is very little doing

Saturday 19

Cold this morning, but mild
towards noon. Fred cutting
fire wood Mr Berley and
his 2 boys drove over at noon
cloudy towards evening
and snowed a little
